

## MPETA AWARD NOMINATION

### **FORM B**

This most prestigious award honors physical educators who provide outstanding teaching performances, who have an exceptional ability to motivate students to participate in physical activity and further physical education in Manitoba. Each year the MPETA Award is presented in Early, Middle and Senior Years categories.

The nominee must have:

- Teaching responsibility for physical education for one or more grades in the category for which they are nominated.
- Must be fully certified to teach in Manitoba and follows the provincial curriculum.
- Minimum of 7 years experience teaching physical education.

In point form, please write your nomination form containing the following criterion. The more specific to the criteria this is written, the greater chance your nominee has in receiving provincial recognition.

1. Describe how the nominee conducts a quality physical education program as reflected in the Manitoba curriculum. Maximum 500 words.
2. Describe how the nominee has established a balanced program that includes a wide range of learning opportunities, a variety of teaching methodologies, utilizes assessment for and of learning and provides innovative, engaging learning experiences. Maximum 500 words.
3. Describe how the nominee provides learning experiences and opportunities in and out of class time that encourage a healthy, active lifestyle. Maximum 500 words
4. Describe how the nominee participates in professional development opportunities related to teaching physical education and also shares their expertise locally, regionally, provincially or nationally. Maximum 500 words.
5. If applicable, describe how the nominee has made a contribution to the field of physical education by positively impacting the teaching of physical education curriculum in the school, region or province. Maximum 500 words.
